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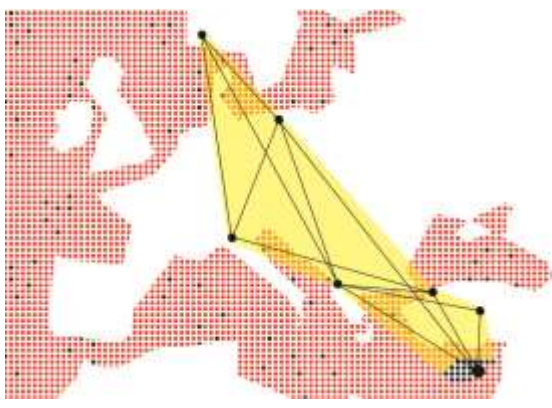

<p>Brief Explanation (aims and expected outcome) (max100 words)</p>	<p>In the existing network of the cities the new nodes called as "Hub" is the living spaces of a new kind of living; transportation, food, work hubs etc. are the places where people (citizens, users) come together. The activities change according to the ongoing facilities. In detail student hub is a space/place where especially the students meet to socialize while keeping privacy of his/her own.
